EXHIBITS REMOVED BEFORE 4:30 P.M. WILL NOT QUALIFY FOR PRIZE MONEY

Any exhibit that does not comply with the requirements printed for any class may be disqualified by either the committee or the judge. Judges have full power to classify all exhibits. The judges are instructed to reduce the amount of the premium or withhold the prize if they consider the best exhibit of a section to be of an inferior quality. The decision of the judge will be final. Appeals will not be considered. Exhibitors interfering with the judge will forfeit their winnings.

As an exhibitor, you represent your livestock's particular commodity group, and the agriculture industry as a whole. It is very important you portray the positive face of agriculture to the public and to fellow exhibitors.

ADVANCE ENTRIES ONLY - MUST BE RECEIVED AT BOX 268, BRIGDEN , NON 1B0 OR BROUGHT TO BRIGDEN FAIR OFFICE ON OR BEFORE SEPT. 21, 2010. EXHIBITOR FEE OF \$5.00 TO BE PAID UPON ENTRY. THERE WILL BE AN ADDITIONAL ENTRY FEE OF 50 CENTS PER BIRD. ANY ENTRIES OR ADDITIONS TO ENTRIES ENTERED AFTER THAT DATE WILL BE CHARGED A LATE FEE OF \$10.00 PLUS \$5.00 EXHIBITOR FEE. 15% of winnings will be retained.

EXHIBITORS LIMITED TO TWO (2) BIRDS PER SECTION

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE TESTED AND DISEASE FREE AS REQUIRED BY GOVERNMENT

Unhealthy or diseased birds will be removed from the show building at the discretion of the committee and will not receive prize money.
