Six classes of Breeding Animals - Limited to one entry per exhibitor per class, except that the fair has authorized two entries per class to a maximum of two classes. The maximum total eligible exhibits per breed from a breeding unit is 8 head (including the single market lamb). Each breed must be shown separately and have at least 3 exhibitors and at least 18 animals. All exhibits must be owned by and registered in name of exhibitor.

Section:

1. Ewe - Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place) Born and bred in Canada
2. Ewe - (1st pair of temporary incisors must be in place) Born on property of the exhibitor
3. Ram - Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place)
4. Ram - (1st pair of temporary incisors must be in place) Born on property of the exhibitor
5. Get-Of-Sire - (born on the property of the exhibitor) A group of three (3) animals, first pair of temporary incisors must be in place, by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented. (Animals may or may not have shown in previous classes. This is at the discretion of the Fair).
6. Breeders Flock - (bred and owned by exhibitor) A group of four (4) animals. Both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed.
7. Best Flock of Sheep - by Peter Welsh in memory of Thomas Welsh Trophy

Novice Showmanship: A chance to learn more about sheep and try your showmanship skills will be provided for children over 3 years of age who are not in the 4-H program. Time to be announced during regular sheep shows.
