**ADVANCE ENTRIES ONLY – MUST BE RECEIVED AT 2976 BRIGDEN ROAD, BRIGDEN, ONTARIO, NON 1B0 OR BROUGHT TO BRIGDEN FAIR OFFICE ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 21, 2010.** Entry fees - \$5.00 per animal per section entered in Class 4 will be payable at time of making entry. In order to print a catalogue, all livestock forms must be legible and accompany entry form.

MOORE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY WILL ACCEPT LATE ENTRIES UP TO OCTOBER 1, 2010 AT A PENALTY OF \$20.00 PER EXHIBITOR. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT COMPLETE LIVESTOCK ENTRY FORM AND \$5.00 ENTRY FEE PER ANIMAL PER SECTION BEING ENTERED, EXHIBITOR FEE, PLUS ANY PENALTY AMOUNT APPLICABLE.

*Note\* Payment of entry and exhibitor fees must accompany registration form. Proof of Liability Insurance must be submitted with entry fees and forms. Must show company and policy number. If fees and forms are not received in the Office by deadline, entries will be VOID.*

**NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES AFTER SEPTEMBER 21, 2010.**

**\*\*Note: 2 substitutions per Exhibitor allowed within the class within sections, any in class out of section substitutions Office must be notified by Monday before show.**

If more than 12 animals are entered in any class, after scratches & substitutions, the class and prize money will be split.

**Unless there are 2 exhibitors per breed, prize money will be paid at the discretion of the Fair. Entry fees and Exhibitor fees will be used in paying of Prize Money.**

Each breeding unit is allowed a maximum of 10 exhibits excluding Breeder's Herd. Each breed must be shown separately and have at least:

- a. 2 exhibitors per breed
- b. 20 animals exhibited per breed
- c. The fair may authorize two exhibits per class in a maximum of 3 classes, except in the Breeder's Herd Class

**“For your dog’s safety, they must be leashed while on the grounds and obey all posted signs.”**

**GENERAL RULES OF ALL BREEDS:** The Federal Department of Agriculture Classifications are adopted for all breeds of cattle. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per section; however, Moore Agricultural Society Directors have authorized two entries per section to a maximum of three sections. The exhibitor has his choice of selecting in which sections to make his second entries. Board of Directors reserves the right to make final decisions on all problems that may arise.

**DEFINITION OF AN ENTRY:** All registered animals, whether owned by one person (individually or jointly) which are maintained on one farm or breeding unit are considered to be the production of one farm or breeding unit. Where the same interests are involved in more than one breeding operation, such operations are considered as ONE breeding unit. Only one entry per class is eligible from such farm or breeding unit, unless authorized by the Fair. All entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor. In group classes the registration certificate for each animal must show the exhibitor as breeder or joint breeder.

Eligibility:

1. A farm related youth aged 10 – 22 who reside inside Lambton County or any adjoining County.
2. Suitable facilities are available to house and care for the animal.
3. Home grown calves and feed can be used.
4. Feed ration will be a 13% grower finishing ration.
5. Maximum selling weight is 1350 pounds, anything over that weight will be donated to the buyer.
