Rules for Division 22:

- A. Open to homes throughout the community of Brigden and within a 20 km radius from the Fairgrounds.
- B. A display of any size or shape to be decorated with any material (suitable medium) to promote the Brigden Fair. For example: hay & straw bales, big or small, corn, rakes, ploughs, flowers, vegetables, etc. Halloween theme not included.
- C. Display must face the road and be on owner's property. May be displayed on another property with owner's permission. Display is NOT permitted on the road allowance.
- D. A sign must accompany the display and be clearly visible from the road. **The sign must state "BRIGDEN FAIR – THANKSGIVING WEEKEND, October 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th, 2018" and include Fair theme "Making Tracks to Brigden Fair"**.
- E. All entries must include your name, address (including 911 address), phone number and directions on a piece of paper.
- F. **Display must remain in place until Tuesday, October 9th 2018.**
- G. Contestants must supply a picture of decorated entry to be on display at the Brigden Fairgrounds during the fair. Print should be 5" x 7" and submitted into the office by October 3rd. An after hours drop-off mail slot is available outside the front office.

Exhibitor is allowed to enter **ONE (1)** exhibit in Division 23.

Home businesses may only enter into one Division (either Div. 22 or Div. 23).

Rules for Division 23:

- A. Open to businesses throughout the community of Brigden and within a 20 km radius from the Fairgrounds. **Business exhibits can be a yard or window display. Window displays must be fully visible from outside.**
- B. A display of any size or shape to be decorated with any material (suitable medium) to promote the Brigden Fair. For example: hay & straw bales, big or small, corn, rakes, ploughs, flowers, vegetables, etc. Halloween theme not included.
- C. Display must face the road and be on owner's property. May be displayed on another property with owner's permission. Display is NOT permitted on the road allowance.
- D. A sign must accompany the display and be clearly visible from the road. **The sign must state "BRIGDEN FAIR – THANKSGIVING WEEKEND, October 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th" and include Fair theme "Making Tracks to Brigden Fair".**
- E. All entries must include your name, address (including 911 address), phone number and directions on a piece of paper.
- F. **Display must remain in place until October 9th, 2018.**
- G. Contestants must supply a picture of decorated entry to be on display at the Brigden Fairgrounds during the fair. Print should be 5" x 7" and submitted into the office by October 2nd. An after hours drop-off mail slot is available outside the front office.
