Removal of exhibits must take place after 4:30 p.m. on Monday, October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018 (POSITIVELY NO EARLIER or prize money will be forfeited).

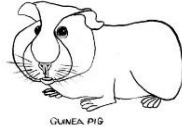
