Exhibitor Fee of \$5 per exhibitor

Exhibitor fees and 10% of noted prize monies will be retained to cover operational costs of show.

MOORE AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY WILL ACCEPT LATE ENTRIES UP TO 10:00AM ON DAY OF SHOW. EXHIBITORS MAY PRE-REGISTER BY SEPTEMBER 25th WITH EXHIBITOR FEE COLLECTED DAY OF SHOW. SUBSTITUTIONS, ADDITIONS, AND SCRATCHES MUST BE CONFIRMED BY 10:00AM DAY OF SHOW. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT COMPLETE LIVESTOCK ENTRY FORM AND EXHIBITOR FEE. All exhibitors under 18 require the signature of the parent/guardian.

Proof of valid Liability Insurance must be submitted with entry fees and forms.
Must show name of company, policy number and expiration date.

All exhibitors taking part in official Breed Point Shows must make advanced entries to allow time for Breed Associations to verify pedigrees and track breeder participation.

Qualification for individual breed show requires a minimum:

- A. 2 Exhibitors Per Breed.
- B. 20 Animals Exhibited Per Breed.

At the discretion of the Beef Show Committee any breed that does not achieve the minimum requirements can be combined with the Any Other Breed classes for the purposes of the show and/or have Prize Money reduced at the discretion of the Fair.

If more than 12 animals are entered in any single class, after scratches & substitutions, the class and prize money will be split at the Beef Show Committee's discretion.

SHOW REGULATIONS:

1. Entry numbers will be provided to the exhibitors by the Beef Show Committee on the day of the show. Numbers must be worn in show ring and be visible for the recording of placings.
2. All entries exhibited in bull classes #2, #3 and #4 along with any subsequent splits or within champion classes, must be shown with humbug or permanent nose ring.
3. All entries exhibited in female classes #9 and #10 in Purebred Divisions A-4G must have purebred natural calf at foot. If calf is not purebred the pair must be exhibited in Division H or I as applicable.
4. Calves exhibited as part of classes #9 and #10 ARE eligible to be shown in classes #1 and #6 as applicable.
5. Multiple animal classes #12 and #13 within Divisions A-G must include only purebred animals. Any groups that contain animals that are not purebred must be exhibited in Division I or J as applicable.
6. Animals may NOT be shown in multiple breed divisions.
7. Exhibitors of purebred cattle and registered percentage cattle must have pedigrees available on day of show. Tattoos and pedigrees checked at the discretion of the Beef Show Committee.
8. All entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor. In group classes the registration certificate for each animal must show the exhibitor as breeder or joint breeder.
9. Exhibitors are required to keep livestock on the grounds and in the designated stalls until 4:30 PM. Violation of release time will result in forfeiture of any prize money earned by entries.
10. All entries exhibited as part of the beef show must be tagged appropriately in accordance with the requirements of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency in combination with the Canadian Cattle Identification Agency.
11. A complete copy of The Brigden Fair Beef Show Rules and Regulations are available by request through the Moore Agricultural Society office or for download on the Brigden Fair Website.
12. The Beef Show Committee reserves the right to make final decisions on all problems arising at the show.

GENERAL RULES OF ALL BREEDS: The Federal Department of Agriculture Classifications are adopted for all breeds of cattle.

In accordance with the BRIGDEN FAIR – RULES AND REGULATIONS, Moore Agricultural Society Directors have authorized two entries per class for each exhibitor. Exhibitors are limited to collecting two prizes in any single class. If more than two entries have been made into a single class, the exhibitor has their choice of which two prizes to collect. The MAS Board of Directors reserve the right to make final decisions on all problems that may arise.

Due to recent regulatory amendments to O. Reg 567 (Rabies Immunization) under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, all livestock that may come in contact with the public must be prepared to provide up-to-date rabies vaccine documentation if requested.

3. Bull – Senior Yearling - born January 1st, 2017 - March 31st, 2017.
4. Bull – Mature - born January 1st, 2016 - December 31st, 2016.
5. **GRAND CHAMPION AND RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION BULL** Ribbons Only
6. Female – Calf - born on or after Jan. 1st, 2018. Minimum of 3 months of age on day of judging.
7. Female – Junior Yearling Heifer - born April 1st, 2017 - December 31st, 2017.
8. Female – Senior Yearling Heifer - born January 1st, 2017 - March 31st, 2017.
9. Female – 2 Year Old - born January 1st, 2016 - December 31st, 2016 with her own 2018 natural calf at foot.
10. Female - born prior to January 1st, 2016, with her own 2018 natural calf at foot.
11. **GRAND CHAMPION AND RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE** Ribbons Only
12. Breeder's Herd - a group of 4 animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented, must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.
13. Get-of-Sire - a group of 3 animals from the same sire, both sexes represented, at least one animal owned by the exhibitor, animals must be shown in previous classes. Limited to one entry per exhibitor.
14. **SUPREME CHAMPION AND RESERVE SUPREME CHAMPION ANIMAL** – Awarded Per Day
 - Supreme Champion \$200.00 plus prize
 - Reserve Supreme Champion Animal \$100.00 plus prize
 - Any sex, any breed. ONLY ONE ENTRY PER EXHIBITOR, must have won their respective class. (Class 5 or 11)
