EXHIBITOR ENTRY RULES:

All exhibitors are required to fill out a Livestock Entry Form. Entry Forms must include complete contact information such as: 911 address, telephone number, email, date and exhibitor's signature. **All exhibitors under 18 require the signature of a parent/guardian.** NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT A COMPLETED ENTRY FORM AND EXHIBITOR FEE.

ADVANCE ENTRIES are encouraged and must be received at the Brigden Fair Office, 2976 Brigden Road, Brigden ON N0N 1B0 **on or before September 25, 2018** by mail or dropped off in person (after-hours mail slot is available). **Online entries will also be available until September 25, 2018 at: www.brigdenfair.ca**

Ringside entries will be accepted – **Livestock Entry Forms MUST be filled out upon registration**, including animal registration number and insurance information.

Exhibitor Fee of \$5 Per Exhibitor.

Exhibitor Fees AND 10% Of Noted Prize Monies Will Be Retained And Used To Cover Operational Costs Of Show.

Proof of valid Liability Insurance must be submitted with entry fees and forms.
Must show name of company, policy number and expiration date.
Random papers and tattoo checks will take place.

Due to recent regulatory amendments to O. Reg 567 (Rabies Immunization) under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, all livestock that may come in contact with the public must be prepared to provide up-to-date rabies vaccine documentation if requested.

The Board of Directors reserve the right to make final decisions on all problems that arise. Trucks must be removed from the area when animals are unloaded and parked in the location designated for that purpose.

Six classes of Breeding Animals - Limited to two entries per exhibitor per class. The maximum total eligible exhibits per breed from a breeding unit is 9 head (including the single market lamb). Each breed must be shown separately. All exhibits must be owned by and registered in name of the exhibitor.

CLASS

1. Ewe - Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place) Born and bred in Canada
2. Ewe - (1st pair of temporary incisors must be in place) Born on property of the exhibitor
3. Ram - Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place)
4. Ram - (1st pair of temporary incisors must be in place) Born on property of the exhibitor
5. Get-Of-Sire - (born on the property of the exhibitor) A group of three (3) animals, first pair of temporary incisors must be in place, by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented. Animals may or may not have shown in previous classes. This is at the discretion of the Fair. To be determined by the score in the first four classes of each division.
6. Breeders Flock - (bred and owned by exhibitor) A group of four (4) animals. Both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed.
7. Best Flock of Sheep on Grounds - \$50 donated by Harold Thompson
 - Best Flock from each division may compete

NOVICE SHOWMANSHIP

A chance to learn more about sheep and try your showmanship skills will be provided for children over 3 years of age who are not in the 4-H program. Time to be announced during regular sheep shows.
