EXHIBITOR ENTRY RULES:

All exhibitors are required to fill out an Entry Form. Entry Forms must include complete contact information such as: 911 address, telephone number, email, date and exhibitor's signature. Exhibitors under 18 require the signature of a parent/guardian. **Entry fees MUST accompany entry forms.**

\$5.00 per exhibitor on or before **September 25th, 2018.**

\$15.00 per exhibitor starting **September 26th, 2018** (\$5 entry fee plus \$10 late fee).

Any substitutions or additions to entries after September 25th will be charged a late fee of \$10.00.

LATE ENTRIES – ACCEPTED UP UNTIL 4 PM TUESDAY OCTOBER 2ND, 2018 – NO EXCEPTIONS!

Exhibits may be brought into the Fair on **Wednesday, October 3rd, 2018 from 12 p.m. to 8 p.m. and on Thursday, October 4th, 2018 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.** Doors will close promptly at 1 p.m. - judging to begin immediately afterward. Removal of exhibits must take place after 4:30 p.m. on Monday, October 8th, 2018 (POSITIVELY NO EARLIER or prize money will be forfeited).

10% of prize monies will be retained to cover operational costs

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED – NO EXCEPTIONS!

Competition Rules:

- **This competition is open to all residents of Lambton County.**
- Advance Entries only! No late entries will be accepted.
- Entry forms **must be received** at the Brigden Fair Office by 4 pm on **Tuesday, September 25, 2018** with an exhibitor fee of \$5.00 **and an 8" x 10" (20 cm x 25 cm) colour photo.**
- Please include the name of the quilt block, along with a type-written story for the barn quilt (i.e. Why was this block chosen? What is the historical link to Lambton County? Is there special meaning for this block? Any historical sites nearby?)
- Entries must be constructed of wood, Medium Density Overlay (MDO) Board, or sturdy weather proof material (i.e. Lexan) and painted by exhibitor/ family. Please refer to the website www.barnquilttrails.ca for advice on prep and painting of patterns.
- The barn quilt art must be mounted ready for judging by the entry date. 911 address and location of the barn quilt on the property must be written on the entry form. This gives permission for judges to come to view the workmanship of the barn quilt.
- Judging will take place between **September 27 and October 4, 2018**
- Photos and winners of competition will be posted at Brigden Fair

CLASS

- 5801. Iron Sculpture (welded) – items to be made from metal materials such as nuts, bolts, wire, horseshoes, chain links, rod, recycled metal. Dimensions of 18" x 18" (45 cm x 45 cm) maximum size
- 5802. Iron Sculpture (non-welded) – items to be made from metal materials such as nuts, bolts, wire, horseshoes, chain links, rod, recycled metal. Dimensions of 18" x 18" (45 cm x 45 cm) maximum size
- 5803. ♦ Sculpture depicting the theme 'Making Tracks to Brigden Fair' (separate class from 5801 & 5802)
- 5804. Horse Shoe Art – dimensions maximum size 24" wide x 36" length (60 cm x 91 cm)
- 5805. Usable item made out of horse shoes (eg: Racks – wine, shoes/boots, magazine, etc.)
- 5806. Metal rack for displaying or hanging items (mixture of mediums allowed)
- 5807. Metal decorative garden ornament
