Animals to be on the grounds by 9:00 am on day of show for weigh in and processing

Due to recent regulatory amendments to O. Reg 567 (Rabies Immunization) under the Health Protection and Promotion Act, all livestock that may come in contact with the public must be prepared to provide up-to-date rabies vaccine documentation.

Prize Money: \$50. \$45. \$40. \$35. \$30. \$25. \$20. \$15. \$12. \$10.

Purpose:

To provide an opportunity for farm related youth to feed, train and care for a beef animal or a market lamb for the purpose of show and sale at the Brigden Fall Fair.

Eligibility:

1. A farm related youth aged 9 - 22 who reside in Lambton County or any adjoining County.
2. Access to facilities that are suitable for the housing and care of the animal.
3. Steers and heifers born January 1st, 2017 – December 31st, 2017 are eligible for show.
4. Wethers and Ewes to weigh 95 – 125 lbs. at time of auction.
5. Advanced entries must be received by May 1, 2018.

General Rules And Regulations:

1. Animals will be exhibited at the Brigden Fall Fair and will be judged on the basis of yield and cutability.
2. Preferred finishing weight for beef animals is 1,350 pounds with maximum of 1,450 pounds.
3. Preferred finishing weight for market lambs is between 95 and 125 pounds.
4. Home grown calves, lambs and feed can be used.
5. Use of implants, steroids and/or additional growth hormones is not permitted in Feeder Club Entries.
6. The Brigden Fair will retain a 5% sales commission from all auction sales.
7. Announcements made at auction will supersede printed advertisements.
8. All animals must be shown by youth exhibitor in Feeder Club Class. If the animal is not shown, it will not be eligible for auction.
9. Animals sold through the Auction are not eligible to be shown in subsequent classes without written consent from buyer.
10. The Board of Directors reserve the right to disqualify any entry they deem unfit for sale into the food system.

The top 10 placing project animals will be entered into the Brigden Fair Livestock Auction.

Committee will be making farm visits throughout the year to monitor animal progress & offer mentorship.
